

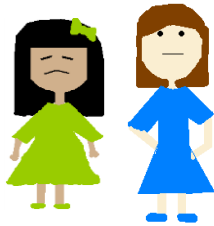
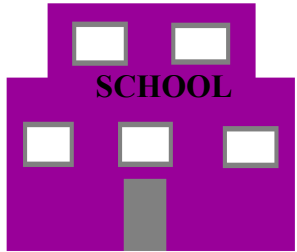

teacher, principal, and school nurse.

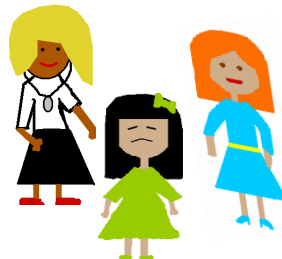


The School calls The

Detective.



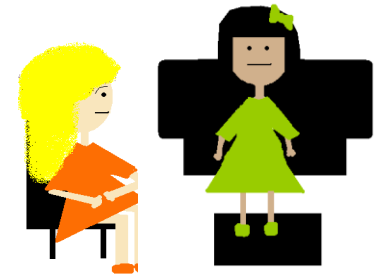
Maria is taken to the

examine and talk to her.



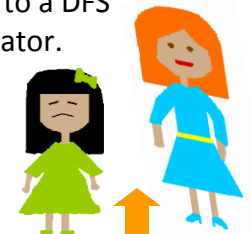
A Counselor talks to
Maria.



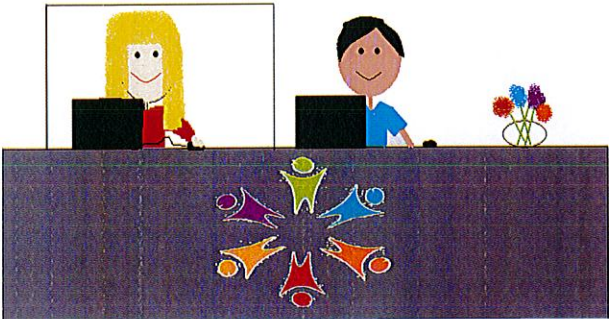
A Lawyer talks to

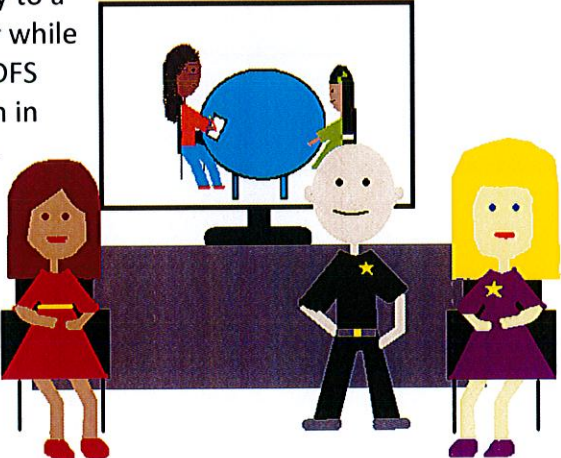
